CALL FOR PAPERS

PARES Research Award



The Luigi Mastroianni Research Award was established by P.A.R.E.S. to recognize excellence in research in the discipline of reproductive endocrinology. The award is open to all current medical students, obstetrics and gynecology residents and reproductive endocrinology fellows in programs associated with the Philadelphia Reproductive Endocrine Society. Original research manuscripts not published prior to January 15, 2018 will be accepted for review. The medical student, resident or fellow must be the first author of the paper. It is expected that the medical student, resident or fellow will have primary responsibility for the literature review, implementation of the study and final drafting of the discussion section. Review articles will not be accepted. Papers should be written in a scientific format to include title, authors, institution, abstract, introduction, materials and methods, results, and discussion and should confirm with the instructions for the <u>American Journal of Obstetrics and Gynecology</u>. *Two copies should be submitted. Both should be saved under the article's title. One copy should have all institution and author information removed.* The award and stipend of \$500 will be conferred at the P.A.R.E.S. meeting on April 19, 2018. The author of the winning paper will be asked to present a brief summary of his/her work at that time.

Manuscripts must be received no later than March 30, 2018, to allow adequate time for review. Any manuscripts received after March 30, 2018 are ineligible for consideration.


